

After a nice introductory part of the meeting, the presentation of the 4th Intellectual Output School Activities (coding workshops, hackathon and role model activity) started with the partner school Ali Osman Sönmez Vocational and Technical High School (AOS MTAL). The coordinator Ümit Erçetin from AOS MTAL made a presentation about the school activities. He presented some statistics about the online coding platform and international students matching activity, the created and exhibited projects on the Code is Loading Platform. The number of users, the number of the active projects, posts etc on the platform were discussed and evaluated by the partners. He also showed some videos about school activities such as hackathons and role model activities in school.



After the presentation of AOS MTAL, Luis Pinheiro the coordinator of AEDS/CCEMS made a presentation about the school activities which were held in October in Portugal. He stated some statistics, showed some photos of the activities and the Multiplier Event which was organized in Portugal. Luis also stated that the feedback he received from the participants in the student activities held within the scope of the project was very positive and that other schools in the region wanted to participate in the activities as a result of the dissemination of the studies and social media posts.





The other partner Liceo-Rosa from Italy was on the stage after CCEMS. The project coordinator Annalisa Vicario made a presentation with a video that includes all the project activities and statistics in the school from the beginning to the end of the project. She also stated the positive feedbacks of the students and some evaluations about the project from the teachers of the partner school. She presented some photos, statistics about the Multiplier Event which was organized with the participation of teachers, academicians, representatives of NGOs etc.

In the second part of the meeting, the project coordinator from Bursa MEM made a presentation on the evaluation of the project. He also presented the Multiplier Event which was organized with 150 participants (legal representatives, directors, teachers, students, entrepreneurs etc) from different institutions, schools, NGOs, different chambers of ICT, etc.



After the general evaluation of the project, he made a presentation of the draft form of final report. He showed the final report form to the project coordinators of the partners and he stated that they will prepare the final report together with the project partners. The questions in the final report were discussed and an agreement was reached on how they should be answered. Project coordinator Hüseyn ŞAHİN said that the draft report will be shared with the project partners and that it should be filled in and sent back to the project coordinator within a certain period of time.



In the last session of the meeting, the projects that could be prepared for the new term Erasmus+ call for proposals were discussed with the project partners. Evaluations were made on the new partnership structure, project applications and sustainable cooperation in the new period.

After the brainstorming session, the meeting was finalized with the certificate ceremony for the participants and everyone left Wadowice with good memories.
